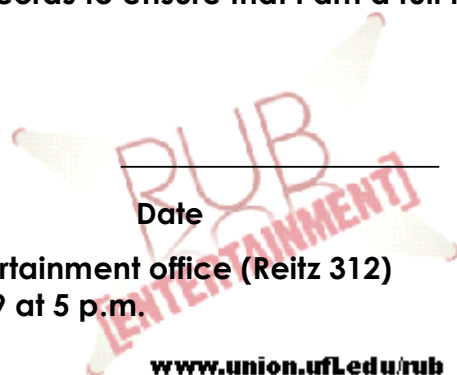

Committee Descriptions

Fall 2009

Bands Committee

The bands committee is responsible for programming events centered on music. This committee maintains a music event series (Local Brew) in the Orange and Brew as well as other music-oriented events using facilities in and around the J. Wayne Reitz Union. Such events include concerts, coffee houses, Karaoke, and student musician showcases.

Films Committee

The films committee is responsible for programming events centered on theatrical entertainment. This responsibility includes the selection and promotion of films, maintaining a weekly film series in the Reitz Union Auditorium, and hosting other events such as film and TV trivia.

Lecturers and Comedians Committee

The lecturers and comedians (LnC) committee provides insight and laughter to the student body. This responsibility includes hosting stand-up comedy shows, comedy film or television show screenings, featured speakers or lecturers, student comical showcases, and special topic forums.

Promotions Committee

The promotions (promo) committee is responsible for the coordination of all public relation efforts, advertising campaigns for RUB Entertainment as a whole, and advertising for specific events. This committee is also responsible programming events to brand RUB Entertainment. This responsibility includes hosting themed, seasonal, craft-making, and interactive events.
