COVID-19 Safety Measures

- Following all recommendations, guidelines, and policies from the CDC, state of Florida, Alachua County, and the University of Florida
- All areas of the facility are thoroughly cleaned and disinfected; all staff wear gloves while cleaning
- Increased the frequency of cleaning high-touch surfaces such as: doorknobs, push bars, elevator buttons, hand railings, furniture, flush valves, sinks, countertops, microwave ovens, and vending machines
- Use of disinfection products registered with the EPA for disinfection of COVID-19
- Meeting spaces are thoroughly cleaned following each reservation
- Limited seating capacities in public areas and meeting spaces to align with recommended distancing guidelines
- Additional hand sanitizer stations installed throughout the facility
- Wellness barriers are installed at key service locations
- Use of high efficiency filters and ultraviolet light disinfection in air conditioning systems
- Implemented training and cleaning protocols for areas if positive exposure occurs
- Face coverings are required for staff, except when alone in private offices

How You Can Help

- Wear a face covering at all times inside this facility
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds; if soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Stay home if you are sick
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash
- Observe physical distancing guidelines and do not rearrange the furniture
